Update on the National Prevalence Study of Elder Abuse

NCPOP is conducting a national prevalence study of elder abuse involving interviews with over 2,000 older people across the country. This is the first study of its kind in Ireland and will provide valuable data on the extent of elder abuse within Irish society. Data collection is currently underway and will be completed by summer 2010.

The primary aims of the study are 1) to measure the overall prevalence of elder abuse and individual types of abuse in a community dwelling population aged 65 years and older and 2) to identify risk factors associated with elder abuse.

NCPOP intends to launch a report of the main findings with a presentation in UCD in November 2010. If you are interested in the study and would like more information please contact NCPop at ncpop@ucd.ie or (01) 716 6467.

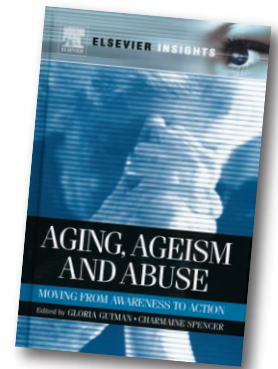
